**Roberta** shared that the Outreach Team is currently exploring a Church/School partnership that may fit well with the above idea.

### **Mission Donations for 2020**

**Motion** by Mary Turfe that this year 70% of all money raised during fundraising events (other than the Soup Sundays) go to the pre-designated mission and 30% go to the DUMW treasury.

Motion seconded by Dianne Kern.

After further discussion the vote was taken and motion passed.

Designation for 2020 mission donations from Easter Egg Bake Sale, Rummage Sale, Cookie Walk/Sale, will be done at the March 22 DUMW meeting. Suggestion made that we ask the District UMW what mission projects they support.

### **Feedback on purchase of new stove for kitchen: Pat**

Pat explored issue with company in Perrysburg, OH. They offer commercial grade equipment. She found that a new Vulcan, 60" model with 6 burners, 2 ovens, griddle, gas stove with delivery and lone year limited warranty would be \$4520. Several questions were asked: Will they pick up old stove? Does it have a fan system?

Next step is to share this information with Trustees, determine if this is the model best suited for kitchen, what funds do Trustees have toward this purchase, what funds does DUMW have (donations at Soup Sundays at present)? What funds would DIVAs be able to contribute?

**Pat will** confer with Trustees to move this plan forward.

### **Funeral Coordination:**

**Jayne will** work with Jeanne to re-do the letter to families for planning. Suggested that they seek input from someone who has had a funeral here (Carole DeSantis, Tammy Bargo, Nancy Durston)

No final decisions made other than we need a team to work out details.

Data on costs indicate that the average DUMW cost (that is currently reimbursed by the family beyond any donation they wish to make), is between \$200 and \$250/standard funeral at DUMC for 100 people.

Next funeral/memorial is planned for May 23ed. Dorothy Durston. Visitation at 10AM. Service at 11:00 AM, and luncheon at 11:45. Jeanne and Jayne will meet prior to this date to revise the existing letter given to family members to help them know what to expect in the planning and luncheon.

**Carole DeSantis** offered to “Buddy” up with anyone new to doing Fellowship Hour treats to make it a less daunting task. **Jayne and Barb** offered to “Buddy” up with new people as well. We may want to actually approach new folks and directly offer to “Buddy” up. **Jayne will** also put an announcement in bulletin to this effect.

Comments/discussion made about how to bring more of the congregation into activities besides simply making written or verbal announcements. It was noted that if individuals are called or asked directly they frequently will agree to help, but are unlikely to just respond to a written or verbal announcement. Suggestion was made that we alter our “invitation/request for help strategy” to a more personal approach. Further discussion of this can be on next month’s agenda.
