GOAL

One of our project goals is Institutional Development for capacity building of the women's training Center'(WTC) of the UMC-Liberia Annual Conference (UMC-LAC) through the construction of girl's dormitory to ease the problems of accommodation for rural women who register with the WTC for skills training in Monrovia. Most of these women do not have relatives to live with while in Monrovia; thus, this training empowerment opportunity is beyond their reach.

We are focusing on completing the Girls' Dormitory of the Women's Training Center of UMC-LAC in Monrovia. This will support our focus to involve all women in accessing our integrated skills training program that prioritizes building their capacities for wealth creation and self-reliance. We seek to motivate rural women to become local innovators and be looked upon as valuable and capable women in the Liberian society.

IMPACT OF THE PROJECT

Completion of the dormitory will have a tremendous positive impact on the rural women in Liberia by providing them a safe place to stay as they leave their villages in pursuit of skill training. Also, the standard of education provided at the WTC will greatly enrich their opportunities to become sustainable heads of families. Graduates will acquire adequate experience to face the challenges of sustainable income generation. Furthermore, there will be beneficial impacts on the communities in which the WTC graduates have/will serve (d).

The Project will also increase employment opportunities for rural women who would be challenged to self employ themselves and enhance their entrepreneurial potentials for them to begin and develop their own businesses.

PROGRESS OF THE DORMITORY PROJECT

The construction of the dormitory is in progress. The major work to complete:

Ceilings

Plastering of the interior

Installing windows

Installing doors

Installing plumbing

Casting of the floor
